



GUIDELINES FOR HALLOWEEN ACTIVITIES



The following are important rules that need to be observed during our Halloween Parade, which will take place on **Friday**, **October 31**st, **2025**, at **9:00** a.m.

- Alternate activities will be provided for those students whose parents do not want them participating in Halloween activities. All students should attend school on this day.
- Students will come to school wearing their costumes. If you would like them to remove their costumes while at school as to not damage them, please have your children either wear their costumes over clothes or bring a change of clothes.
- No weapons or replica weapons are to be brought to school.
- No costumes may include props or equipment that is unsafe.
- Mask may not completely obscure the identity of the student. However, masks may be worn during a parade or other specific activity, provided that safety is not hindered.
- No costume can be worn that is unsafe or that may create a safety hazard. Costumes may not impair a student's vision or movement (e.g., ability to climb stairs).
- Costumes shall not be demeaning to any person or group based on age, disability, ethnicity, gender, gender identity, nationality, race, religion, sex, sexual orientation or to any individual staff or student at the school.
